Addition 22,500 square ft. Bid August 30, 2001. Completed June 1, 2003 (on time). Construction cost 512,604,428. State Reimbursement 33.59%

Serving 928 students in grades 6 - 8. Restoration of an existing building to preserve its landmark presence. Construction of new additions designed to compliment and enhance its original appearance. Additions: Two-Story Classroom Wing, Kitchen, Cafeteria, Offices, and Main Entrance. Building Envelope Enhancements include: aluminum window replacement replicating original design, restoration of concrete, face brick, terra cotta, and metal mansard facade elements. Interior Renovation: finishes, mechanical and electrical systems to accommodate current and future program requirements for Classrooms, Media Center, Music, Art, Family Consumer Sciences, and Technology Education. HHSDR provided full design and construction administration beginning in 2003.
