The ASB is sited adjacent to the President's Residence and Art Building 3. It replaces a small, remote and poorly equipped and sited space.

The ASB has increased student and faculty interest.

Building elements

- Metal building envelope.
- Major spaces: a wood shop, metal shop / foundry and classroom.
- Open high bay areas created through a rigid steel frame structure, provide spaces for ducts, hoods and oversized equipment.
- A clerestory window / dormer wall provides north lighting in all areas.
- The external metal siding, roofing and trim color scheme create visual interest.
- A circular, brick wall enclosing an outdoor plaza, used for fabrication, teaching and displaying student work.
