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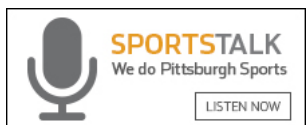
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Shaler Area board opens bids for new Rogers Primary school

Shaler Area school officials received bids on Wednesday for a \$25 million, two-story Rogers Primary school on Scott Avenue.

The board will vote to award contracts later this month. The following contracts will be voted on: Nello Construction, Inc. for general construction at \$15.9 million; East-West Manufacturing & Supply Inc. for HVAC construction at \$2.5 million; Vrabel Plumbing Inc. for plumbing construction at \$1,2 million; A-1 Electric Inc. for electrical construction at \$1.8; Bova Corp./Gateway Kitchen Equipment for food service equipment at \$256,711; and American Communications, Inc. for tele-data cabling at \$185,850.

The school board in April approved a bond not to exceed \$15.7 million toward the construction.

Steve Massaro and Dan Kiefer, construction management, told the board a scope review will take place before contracts are awarded to make sure there is clarity, though they said the numbers looked good.

"There's nothing on here that raises a red flag," he said. "We're happy."

The board will also vote to appoint WAE Balancing, Inc. for the HVAC Commissioning Agent at \$69,000 and Geo Mechanics, Inc. for geotechnical inspection services not to exceed \$99,850.

Shaler Township will be paid \$108,750 for the building permit and inspections associated with the school project.

The school board in April approved a bond not to exceed \$15.7 million, toward the construction.

A school at the Scott Avenue site was damaged by a fire in April 2015. The fire was contained to a mechanical room, but there was smoke damage throughout the building.

Rogers Primary housed students in kindergarten through third grade. The Shaler Area School District enrolled more than 4,400 students in the 2015-16 school year from Shaler, Reserve, Etna and Millvale.

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
